Reading and Phonics

Please comment on the reading log inside your child's book bag and state simply if your child enjoyed the book or any questions they asked. Eventually the book will change to books from the school's reading scheme, once your child is confident blending and segmenting words. This will happen only when your child is ready, it is not a race, do not worry!

This half term we have started teaching letter sounds, please find the pre-cursive formation sheet on our webpage.

Year 1

Children in year 1 will be bringing home a reading book, please allow your child to read their book to you and write a comment in the reading log. Children are currently revisiting the letter sounds and are using these to become independent in reading and writing words and sentences.

Maths

We teach maths using Numberblocks, alongside the White Rose scheme (both can be accessed on the internet). This way of teaching enables the children to have a deeper understanding of number, how numbers are made up, patterns of number and using numbers in a variety of real life contexts.
