Numeracy

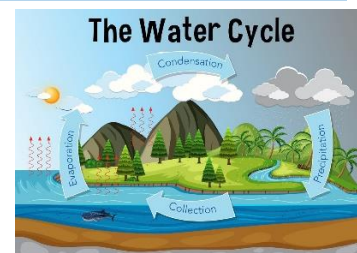
Our focus this half term will be on continuing to learn our times tables. We will also develop our place value knowledge, application of the four operations and will look at our measuring skills.
